- Hold an unencumbered registered/licensed practical nurse license in the state of North Carolina or compact state.
- Must possess leadership ability and the willingness to cooperate with other department heads and personnel.
- Must be in good mental and physical condition and have the ability to organize, plan and direct nursing care.
